Port of Aalborg safety regulations for terminal areas

PORT OF AALBORG

Conduct and restrictions



The entire terminal area within the gates is subject to the ISPS code (official international ship and port security regulations).



Only staff and approved visitors on legitimate business may enter the ISPS area.



Be aware of the operational traffic of trucks, forklifts, reach stackers and other heavy vehicles.



The speed limit in the port area is 30 km/h.



Alcohol and other intoxicants are not permitted.

VIOLATION

Violation of the applicable regulations can result in expulsion from the port area.



Personal protective equipment



An approved safety vest (class 2) or other such approved safety clothing must be worn when moving within all port areas.



Safety footwear must always be worn when moving within quayside areas and anywhere within the Oil terminal.



Safety headwear must always be worn when working from height, moving around cranes and anywhere within the Oil terminal.

Tenants, tradesmen and contractors must bring the necessary personal protective equipment themselves for the performance of their work.

Be aware that special conditions apply in certain areas of the port, e.g., at Bladt industries, Siemens Gamesa and the container terminal. Special safety regulations set by the respective companies apply in these areas.
